

# Theodor

White wine produced from the Manzoni Bianco 6.0.13 grape variety (100%)

<b>DENOMINATION</b>	IGT Vigneti delle Dolomiti. Manzoni Bianco Vintage
<b>COLOUR</b>	Bright straw yellow color, strong, with greenish reflections. Variety that makes elegance and delicacy the essential characteristics.
<b>NOSE</b>	Intense citrus notes of green apple and elderberry on the nose.
<b>PALATE</b>	On the palate the fresh acidity emerges which then leaves room for the complexity and richness typical of this variety.
<b>PRODUCTION AREA</b>	Theodor was born from the highest vineyard of the company at 500 m.a.s.l. on the Trento hill (Guyot training system, low yield per vine, south / west exposure).
<b>VINIFICATION</b>	Manzoni Bianco 6.0.13 (Incrocio Manzoni) is a grape variety born from the various cross between Riesling Renano and Pinot Bianco. The vinification takes place through manual harvesting of the grapes and vinification in steel at a controlled temperature. Slight permanence on post-fermentation noble lees.
<b>PAIRINGS</b>	Ideal with appetizers, delicate first courses and vegetable dishes
